

Chesapeake Materials is pleased to announce our partnership with the Marine Trades Association of Maryland to create and manage a recycling program for plastic boat wrap generated from member marinas. The program strives to regulate collection of boat wrap at the marina level and manage the pickup of the collected film keeping it suitable for recycling.

Each participating boat in the program will be provided a LDPE bag for collection of the film and each marina or third party remover of the film will be instructed how to keep the film clean and suitable for recycling. The program was designed based on a similar and successful effort made by a sister Marine Trade Association.

Headquartered in Edgewater, Maryland, Chesapeake Materials was founded in 2011 and is focused on recycling and reuse of plastic materials. We participated in recycling almost 100 million pounds of plastic in the last 12 month period.

As boat wrap removal ramps up in the spring we will organize collection based on the volume and location of the member marina.

We look forward to working together to solve the problem of boat wrap film waste and are happy to lend our hand and experience to the project.
